

## **Cary getting 513 jobs via HCL Technologies**

CARY - HCL Technologies, the Indian consulting firm that last month pledged to create 513 jobs in Wake County, chose Cary for its local operation.

The company's U.S. subsidiary, HCL Technologies, agreed to lease 42,200 square feet at 11000 Regency Parkway, said Jessica Brock, the Spectrum Properties broker who represented landlord Intercontinental Real Estate of Boston. HCL will occupy the space in the Regency Lakeview office complex in January.

HCL said last month that it would expand in the Triangle during the next five years, adding jobs with average pay of \$46,660 a year.

The state promised the company a grant worth as much as \$5.07 million to win the expansion.

HCL also considered sites in Texas and Arizona.

HCL received no local incentives because it decided to lease rather than build a facility.
